Bhutan, a Buddhist kingdom on the Himalayas' eastern edge, is known for its Monasteries, fortresses (or Dzongs) and dramatic landscapes that range from subtropical plains to steep mountains and valleys. It is a tiny Himalayan Kingdom situated in the eastern Himalayas and landlocked between the world's two most populous nations-with China to the North and India to the South. A Buddhist kingdom with a population of about 800,000 people, pristine environment, well preserved culture and a land of Gross National Happiness, is one of the most sought-after travel destinations in the world today having ranked the second top travel destinations in the world.

DETAIL ITINERARY

DAY 1 –Arrival at Bagdogra and transfer to Phuentsholing

- Arrive at Bagdogra airport and drive to Phuentsholing
- Complete the Check in formalities
- Check into the hotel
- Overnight stay will be at Phuentsholing

DAY 2 – Phuentsholing to Paro

- Breakfast in the Hotel
- Complete the Immigration formalities
- Drive to Paro Via Kharbandi Goenpa
- Stop at Milarepa Tower and Proceed to Paro
- Enroute drive through picturesque towns
- Gedu, Chukha, and Chuzom Stop at Tachog Monestey
- Visit Paro Dzong – Long and Fascinating
- Try National Attire-optional-self paid
- Leisure in Town.
- Overnight stay will be at Paro

DETAIL ITINERARY

DAY 3 – Paro Local Sightseeing (Hike to TIGER NEST)

- Breakfast in the Hotel
- Day hike to Tiger Nest Temple (5hrs walk) perched on a rock overlooking a sheer drop and clings seemingly impossible to a cliff of rock at 900m above the valley floor.
- Evening leisure in the town or can go for hot stone bath - Optional. Overnight stay will be at Paro

DAY 4 – Paro to Phobjikha to Punakha

- Breakfast in the hotel and drive to Phobjikha
- Visit Dochula Pass (3150m.), 108 Druk Wangyel Chortens, Walk through the Gangtey Natural Trail and visit Crane centre , gangtey gompa and drive back to Punakha. Overnight stay at Punakha

DAY 5 – Punakha to Thimphu

- Breakfast in the hotel and Hike to Chimmi lhakang – the temple of Fertility.
- Visit Punakha Dzong, Suspension bridge
- Drive to Thimphu and visit Lamperi Park on the way
- Overnight stay will be at Thimphu

DAY 6- Thimpu to Phuentsholing

- Breakfast in the Hotel
- Visit Buddha viewpoint
- Visit Simply Bhutan – A living Museum -if it is open
- Drive to BBS Tower -Hike to wangditse, View Takin Preserve
- Drive to Phuentsholing
- Complete the Exit formalities- check in as a walk-in customer
- Overnight stay will be at Phuentsholing

DAY 7 – Departure: End of the tour

- Breakfast in the Hotel and drive to Bagdogra for Departure.
- Tour terminates here.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Generally, in Bhutan bargaining is NOT practiced or exercised.
- Customers generally request and NOT demand discount.
- Import of cigarette requires a permit available at entry point Smoking without a valid permit inviting a fine. Smoking is NOT permitted in public areas and Vehicles.
- Dress code must be followed as per prescription especially at sensitive places such as places of worship, fortresses, monasteries...Etc.
- Littering is NOT encouraged.
- Obey safety instructions given by local guide in regards to protective clothing's, physical activities, and places that might compromise safety i.e., rivers, cliffs ... etc.
- Indian Currency is accepted and the value is same .
- Tipping is welcomed, usually 10% of the bill.
- Photography of religious artifacts and important personalities need discretion, sometimes permission

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Forbidden areas must NOT be intruded as it may be places of worship and sensitivity.
- Cross mail Street at designated zebra crossing only. Walk on footpath only
- Public toilets are limited; plan accordingly when leaving the Hotel. Ask guide for information.
- Finger pointing is NOT regarded or appreciated
- Speak at a time, raising a voice is considered rude as most of the Bhutanese are soft spoken. English is widely spoken and understood
- Bhutanese respect privacy, if spoken to, Bhutanese will answer, if approached, - service will be given.
- Ensure that you carry your medications as the same formulation may not be available in Bhutan.
- Carry Your Passport and tickets in an easy to access pouch or bag.
- Do not pack sharp objects such as knives, scissors, penknives etc. in your hand luggage.

TRAVEL DOCUMENT REQUIRED

- Travel Insurance
- Vaccination certificate or Evidence of COVID-19 infection in the last six month
- Guide license copy
- Valid Passport / voters Id
- Kids- Passport / birth certificate in English Translation

Note: Sightseeing will be from 9am -5pm as per the govt. rule

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The Bike will be the responsibility of the rider once its handover to the rider.
- If any damage to the bike will be borne by the rider if there is an accident.
- Fuel will be filled by the rider.
- Rider will follow the road captain during the ride.
- Valid riding licenses will be only permitted to ride the bikes.
- No cancellation of the booking after bikes are booked.
- Biking rental period is only for 06 Days.
- Bikes will NOT be allowed to used SOLO without RC and backup VAN.
- All down payments will be cleared before handing bikes to the riders

It is required to sign the disclaimer before handing over of the bikes to the RIDER.
